

2019 Scholarship Application Guidelines

Objective

The objective of the RT Communications, Inc. Scholarship is to assist individuals who desire to further his/her education through an accredited junior college, technical school, four-year college or university. The Company will offer up to four (4) \$1,000 scholarships to qualified students.

Selection

Selections for the Scholarship Awards will be based on these factors:

- Applicant has grades from high school and/or continuing college/technical school grades.
- **2** Applicant demonstrates community involvement and/or other extracurricular activities. Exhibits leadership qualities.
- Applicant demonstrates that their education/activities facilitate a stated educational goal.
- Applicant has a financial need for the scholarship.

Eligibility

- Applicants must be a customer, a customer's dependent or a dependent of a RT Communications'
- employee. RT account number or RT exchange phone number must be included on application.
- Applicants should be a graduating senior or have graduated from an accredited public, parochial or private high school.
- Applicants must be entering or be enrolled in an accredited junior college, technical school, fouryear college or university.

Procedure

- Applicant must complete, sign and return the application form to RT no later than March 15, 2019.
- Provide a copy of current transcript with cumulative grade point average and SAT/ACT scores, if available, or equivalent college or trade school transcript.
- Provide a one-page essay on how your education and/or extracurricular activities have facilitated your educational goal.
- Complete the Financial Statement to help the Scholarship Committee determine your financial need.
- Provide no more than one (1) letter of recommendation.
